

EU launches new probe into US biodiesel imports

The European Commission has launched an investigation into allegations that US biodiesel is being imported into Europe via third countries such as Canada and Singapore to evade anti-dumping duties introduced by the EU executive last year.

The investigation follows a complaint from European biodiesel association EBB, which [warned of "widespread trafficking"](#) earlier this year. EBB cites the case of a shipment from Canada seized in Italy, which it claims was from US origin. The EU investigation will be carried out over the next nine months.
